Table View United has a full children and youth's ministry catering for young people from the ages of 3 to 20 years old.

In this month's edition we are going to focus on the youngest group called Noah's Ark. Their classroom is based in the far left corner of the church grounds with blue flags around it and a jungle gym in front of it.

This class caters for all children from 3 to 7 years old (not yet in grade one "big school")



The curriculum used is created by Scripture Union and the range is called “Bubbles”. The Sunday agenda includes a structured lesson, then an activity planned to support the lesson. There is usually a craft item which they make. After the lesson, they have free time where they can play with Duplo blocks, play dough, colouring in and toys.

There are 5 trained teachers who rotate every week and are doing a wonderful job!

MARK OF THE LION SERIES BY FRANCINE RIVERS

The civilized world is in the grip of the Roman Empire at the peak of its powers. Some 70 years after the coming of Christ we meet Hadassah; a fifteen year old Jewish peasant girl, who watches her family killed before her very eyes during the slaughter of her people in the fall of Jerusalem. Taken into slavery, what could she possibly have in common with a muscle-bound blonde haired Germanic tribesman, who is chief of his clan, in the desperate battle between the barbarian tribes and the Roman legions?

Their destinies are intertwined in this epic sweeping saga. Atretes, the blonde Adonis of his people is also captured and forced into slavery. Alone in a foreign world Atretes is sold into the deathly world of the arenas of Rome and forced to fight or die as a gladiator for the pleasure of the Roman crowds.

Hadassah finds herself a servant to one of the wealthiest families in Rome, where pagan gods and debauched parties are the order of the day. The two grown children of the family, Julia and Marcus are spoiled and entitled in every way.

Marcus lives for status and riches while his sister lives for every earthly pleasure. Undermined at every turn by her environment, Hadassah desperately clings to her faith and becomes the most trusted of the servants of their household. Against all odds she finds Christian fellowship at a time when Christianity is forbidden by both Jews and Romans alike.

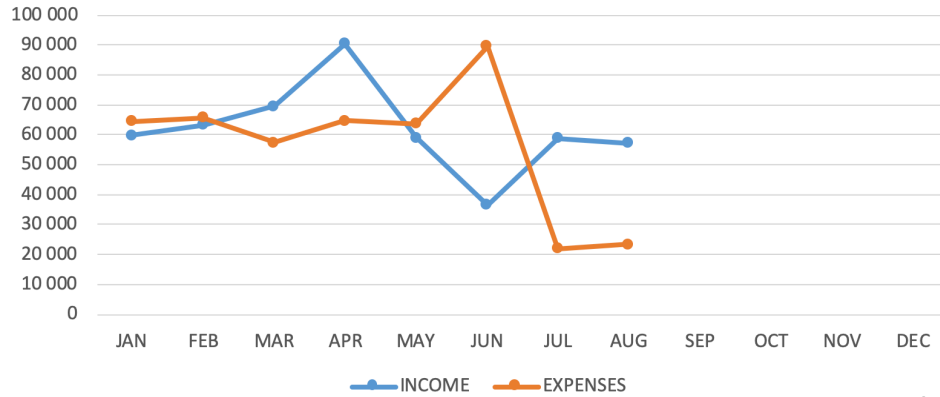
Atretes on the other hand rises to become the most successful and adored Gladiator of his age. However, his victories are hollow and he longs only for freedom and the chance to return to his people.

Tragedy awaits for many of the characters in this golden age of Rome's opulence, but God is at work, and through faithfulness and prayer, we see Him work for change and His goodness, despite horrific circumstances.

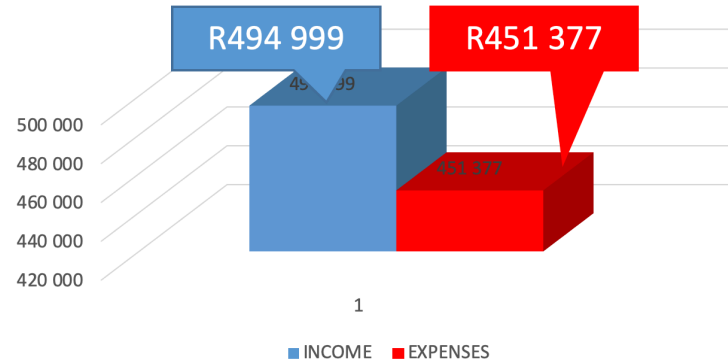
