From the Minister's desk...

To my beloved family at Table View United Church



Lent. A time of reflecting. A time of repentance. A time of preparation. Much like Advent, the purpose of Lent is to prepare one's heart for the events of Easter. For many of us, we have sat in church over Easter weekend for most of our lives, hearing once again the story of how God came as Jesus to die on a cross for our sins. We dance the ritualistic dance of waking up early on a public holiday known as "Good Friday", aware the only thing making it good is the off day that comes with it, and the only thing that makes it a little bit less good is the trudge to church.

We get ready, climb into our cars, and come to church to see the same faces, greet with the same smiles, hear the same sermon, and climb back into our cars for the same drive home as we do every Sunday, except it's Friday, aware that in two days time we'll be dancing this dance again. But hey, at least Monday is also a public holiday!

Easter

If Easter for you feels a little bit like what I described in these last two paragraphs, then I encourage you to take this time of Lent a little more seriously than you have before. Yes, you might be starting a few days late, but you know what, we serve a God who forgives. I'm sure He'll let this one slide. See, there's beauty in the story of Easter. Some people remember that beauty every year at the Easter services, some every second or third year. But what we should be aiming for is to see the beauty of the Easter message daily. Every day to wake up and realise we serve the awesome God who has all power and all knowledge, the triune God who is completely content within Himself, the God who honestly has no need for creation or human beings to be satisfied.

That God, who in the beginning..

decided to create, not out of boredom or desire to brag, but out of love. That God who, when humanity fell, promised to take the worst of it upon Himself. That God who laid the very path to forgiveness throughout the Old Testament, showing His people over and over how He loves them and will take them back if they repent, no matter the severity of what they did. That God who came to a virgin in ancient Israel and promised that in her womb would grow Himself as Jesus, the true Lamb of God, who would live and teach how to have a true relationship with the Father, and then die so that we can truly apply that teaching to our now possible relationship with the Father. But He didn't stay dead, He rose again victorious by the power of the Spirit, conquering the power of sin and death, so that we need not ever fear separation from the Father but live eternally with Him once we fall asleep here on earth.



I dunno about you, but man, that's one wonderful story. And if you do not feel like you are ready to hear that awesome story once again this year, then use this time of Lent to prepare yourself for it! Spend some time praying, fasting, and meditating on the Word of God, because the story of Easter is truly a life-changing story. It changed the course of history! And it will daily change your life if you allow it to, through the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

As the old hymn says,

“Tell me the old old story, of unseen things above, of Jesus and His glory, of Jesus and His love... Tell me the story slowly, that I may take it in - that wonderful redemption, God’s remedy for sin... Tell me the story softly, with earnest tones and grave; remember I’m a sinner whom Jesus came to save... Tell me the same old story, when you have cause to fear that this world’s empty glory is costing me too dear; And when the Lord’s bright glory is dawning on my soul, tell me the old, old story: “Christ Jesus makes thee whole.”

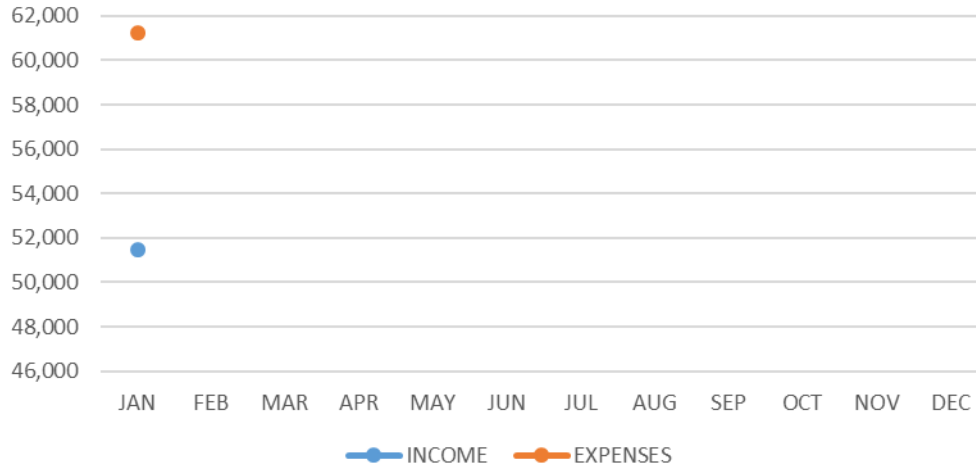
